A MeriTalk report <u>finds</u> that governments spend \$342 billion annually on providing care through public programs to people who aren't eligible. Lack of data integration is thought to be a big



contributing factor: 44 percent of IT professionals surveyed contend they aren't able to access all the necessary data due to system and integration challenges. Just over 20 percent say their current IT system is "analytical," while only 16 percent believe their system to be "intuitive."
